# Me and My Supervisor



## Objective

In this online workshop, the trainer will focus on the importance and the complexity of the doctoral supervisory relationship by covering three main aspects:

- 1. Active design of the supervisory relationship
- 2. Navigating hierarchies
- 3. Effective communication



## Description

Participants in the workshop will be introduced to strategies for establishing and maintaining a productive relationship with their supervisors. They will be offered tips to learn how to navigate the sometimes challenging relationship with their supervisor, address problems professionally, and build positive interactions.

Advice is given on the basic structure of the supervisory relationship in German academia.

In terms of the workshop delivery, the trainer will begin by providing the participants with input about the subject matter. Then, participants will be encouraged to ask questions and discuss the material presented. Afterwards, the participants will be presented with some exercises. Finally, the trainer will discuss some techniques that doctoral candidates can use to improve their relationship with their supervisor.
